1. Have camped at two different campsites in Kent
2. Run an activity as a result of one of your Troop Forum meetings
3. Take part in an activity with Explorer Scouts in your District or with your local Girl Guides
4. Visit your local Cub Pack to promote your Troop or help at a Beaver Scout activity
5. Help at a Group fundraising event



1. Take part in a District camp or District-run badge course
2. Represent your Group in a District competition
3. Write an article for your District newsletter or attend a District Scout Section Forum
4. Take part in a joint activity with another Troop in your District
5. Any other activity agreed with your Scout Leader



1. Attend a County-run activity day, challenge event or badge course
2. Write an article for the County newsletter or attend a County Scout Section Forum
3. Take part in a joint activity with a Troop in another District in Kent
4. Take part in an Invicta Mountaineering Club activity or Kent Scouts' Water Activities Team activity
5. Earn Kent Scouts' Scout Mate Badge



1. Take part in an activity or camp at a National Activity Centre or take part in an International Jamboree in the UK or abroad
2. Write an article and get it published in Scouting Magazine or on www.scouts.org.uk
3. Attend a national Scout activity or event – www.youthfundays.co.uk
4. Raise funds for a national charity
5. Any other activity agreed with your ADC Scouts

PLEASE NOTE: The award works on a "rolling year" not necessarily the calendar year. e.g. If your first challenge is dated 3rd March 2012 then the year for the Award would end on the 2nd March 2013 and all challenges must be completed within those 12 months.
